Several of us attended the FMCA Western Area Rally at the Riverside County Fairgrounds in Indio, CA in January (with me staying in a local hotel!). This is always the largest Area Rally of the 10 Areas in FMCA, and had not been held the last 2 years (due to the pandemic). As always, there were a lot of attendees (although somewhat less this year – about 700+ RVs), they still had quite a few exhibitors and MANY seminars (for which our chapter members volunteered again to help monitor). This Rally is going to be held again next year: Jan 10-14 in 2024. As we have done several times before, we are going to look at possibly having some type of Chapter activity prior to this Rally, or at least encourage our members to attend the Rally and join up prior to entering so we can get good parking spaces as volunteers. We'll have more info on that in the coming months.

Upcoming very soon is the Annual Alfa Owners Rally (Apr 17-24, 2023) put on by the Alfa Owners Club chapters, with the chapter pre-rallies starting about Apr 12. I don't now if the deadline for Rally signups will have passed by the time you read this newsletter, but if you decide at the last minute you'd like to go, please contact the Rally Masters Mark Vella and Steve May ASAP. This is an excellent time to meet with many other Alfa owners, and gain/contribute to our knowledge of Alfa RVs.

There is a list of some upcoming rallies elsewhere in this newsletter, but I wanted to highlight the FMCA International Convention that will be held in Gillette, WY Aug 23-26, 2023 at which Marvin Berry is currently planning to represent out Chapter at the Governing Board meeting during the convention. As you'll see from the list of Rallies, there are a

number of Area Rallies upcoming in 2023 too.

We held our annual Chapter business meeting in Brenda, AZ (near Quartzsite, AZ) during the South Loafers outing in Jan 2023, as many of us South Loafers members are also AlfaSee Yas members, as well as there being a number of AlfaSeeYas members staying in other locations in the Quartzsite area at that time who were also able to attend. The detailed meeting minutes will be posted on our chapter web site, but I wanted to give you a summary here. We had 31 attendees at our chapter meeting. One of the highlights was Paul Mitchell, President of the FMCA INTO Area (which our chapter falls under in FMCA), presented us with a Chapter 20 year anniversary certificate, recognizing our chapter for having been in existence for 20 years. Pictures of the certificate and him presenting it are in the newsletter and will be on our webpage. Paul also updated us on FMCA topics, including reminding us of the value of FMCAssist (which comes with our membership), as well as other advantages of being members of FMCA - particularly the great discount on tires. Nancy McDowell, our Secretary/Treasurer gave us the treasurer's report - we have a very healthy treasury, and are able to support Chapter rallies/outings and volunteer wagon masters. *Hint:* we need volunteers to put on Chapter outings/rallies – it's easy and rewarding to do! The National Director's report was given by Marvin Berry, covering the Governing Board meeting held at the FMCA International Convention last year (his report was in our last newsletter). We recognized Jeannette Harper for her continued service as our Chapter newsletter editor and webmaster - thank you Jeannette! We also reminded folks of the fuel savings cards that provide significant savings - including the TSD Logistics card, Mudflap, and Gas Buddy card. Paul Mitchell told us that the FMCA TCS card program is ending June 1, 2023.

At this time, we don't have any AlfaSee Yas Rallies planned for 2023. We very much encourage you to volunteer to be a chapter Rally Master – you get to pick the Rally dates and location! Rally Guidelines for Wagon Masters are on our Chapter web site. The guide provides tips to novice as well as seasoned wagon masters in preparing, organizing, and executing a rally. There are several incentives for wagon masters and co-wagon masters when hosting a rally such as: You get to pick when and where the Rally will be; you will be reimbursed by the Chapter Treasury for your site fees for starting the night prior to the start of the rally through the last night of the rally; your basic rally registration fee will be waived; and, if this is your first rally as an AlfaSee Yas Chapter Wagon Master or Co-Wagon Master, you will receive personalized Chapter jackets.

I sure all hope you have a great rest of 2023 – and have a great time on all the RVing adventures our Alfas allow us to take!



Recipe - Pumpkin Pound Cake

Ingredients:

- 3 c all purpose flour
- 1 1/2 c sugar
- 1 c brown sugar
- 1 c melted butter *
- 3 eggs
- 2 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp pumpkin spice
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1/4 tsp ground all spice
- 1 150z can of pumpkin (not pumpkin mix)

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. (Spray and prepare a bundt pan)
- 2. Using a mixer, mix sugar (white and brown) and melted butter together.
- 3. Add eggs one at a time and continue mixing.
- 4. Add in flour, baking soda, pumpkin spice, all spice, vanilla and pumpkin. Mix well.

This will be a thick heavy batter. Pour evenly into prepared bundt pan. (Mine was about 3/4 full.)

- 5. Bake for 60-65 minutes or until it tests done.
- 6. Let sit in pan 10 minutes then remove.

^{*} the recipe calls for unsalted butter but I always use salted as that's what's in my fridge...
