Additional Details/Information:

As mentioned previously, the optional trip to the Thousand Springs Art Festival, along with then having lunch and going on a tour of the Fish Hatchery will be a fairly long day. We plan on car-pooling on this trip. For the Festival, there is a charge of approx. \$6 per person for adults/\$5 for seniors, to be paid at the gate. The \$6 charge on the Rally registration form is for a box lunch and a drink - which the Rally Masters will bring with us. There may be a charge of \$4 per vehicle for the park where we are going to picnic for lunch, but there is no charge for the fish hatchery tour. The fish hatchery is absolutely amazing - Terry and I went through it last year! However, if you feel you want to go to the Art Festival but cannot stay away long enough to also go to lunch and/or the fish hatchery, please let me know, and we should be able to work out separate car pools.

In case you were not aware of it, the South Loafers Chapter owners club is having a "Golden Anniversary" outing (especially to celebrate those couples married 50 years or more) at the Jackson Rancheria RV Park (in Jackson, CA) Oct 2-7, 2018. It looks like it will be a lot of fun! A number of us are already signed up to attend it too. Be advised that reservations are already open and limited for this outing, so you should contact her ASAP!

For those of you who will be going on to the South Loafers owners chapter outing at Jackson Rancheria in California, it is approx. 600 miles from Hagerman, ID to Jackson, CA. It looks like 3 driving days (much on freeways) will get us there fairly easily. We are planning on driving about 1/3 the way - to Elko, NV on Sep 26, staying at the Elko RV Park for 3 nights, and departing there on Sep 29. We will then drive about another 1/3 the way to Reno/Sparks, NV, staying at the Grand Sierra Resort RV park for 3 nights, departing Oct 2. We will then drive the remaining 1/3 the way to Jackson Rancheria. Anyone wanting to caravan and stay at the same parks is welcome to do so. Naturally, you are free to travel however you'd like. I'd recommend making reservations at the Elko and Reno parks as soon as you can (especially since there are many summer activities going on in Reno). We can work out caravanning details prior to departing Hagerman.
